Documents which foreign students are required to submit:

- Personal application form (enroll on-line <http://www.wsb.pl/gdansk/rekrutacja-online>)
- 2 photographs
- A copy of the passport
- copy of the visa or the residence card or the Polish Card (if you do not have it – a declaration of submitting a missing document)
- A copy of the medical certificate with its Polish translation
- A copy of the insurance policy with its Polish translation or the European Health Insurance Card (if you do not have it – a declaration of joining the Polish NHS)
- A copy of the matriculation/A level certificate with the apostille or its validation
- A copy of the matriculation/A level certificate supplement with the apostille or its validation
- A copy of the Polish translation of the matriculation/A level certificate
- A copy of the Polish translation of the matriculation/A level certificate supplement
- A copy of the certificate of a Polish course completion (not required if study courses in English are selected – in such a case no language certificates are required)
- A certificate of applying for validation, if required
- Parent's/legal guardian's consent to sign the Contract for Providing Education Services (if the candidate is underage)
- 2x Contract for Providing Education Services (to be completed at the Recruitment Office)

How to apply

Step 1

Select a major study course you wish to attend. Enroll on-line (complete an application form at www.wsb.pl/gdansk. The system will automatically generate the completed documents which shall be returned to the e-mail address you have stated).

Step 2

Collect and complete all the required documentation (see above). Please, remember that to obtain a certificate of being admitted to the study courses you need to provide all the required recruitment documents.

Step 3

Contact our International Recruitment Office before you send all documents by post. After contacting our team and getting confirmation that all documents are correct, please send them to WSB University in Gdansk by post.

After receiving all documents we will contact you in order to inform you about further procedures.

Step 4

After at least 3 days since the date of the tuition fee transfer, please contact the International Recruitment Office to receive your certificate of being admitted to study courses at WSB.



The International Recruitment Office shall inform you about an appointed date on which you shall be given an access to the EXTRANET, a virtual system where you shall find the information about the lecture and class schedules, the date of the academic year commencement and others.
