Dear Prof. Kozłowski,

In response to your letter concerning the recognition of higher education institutions in Poland by the Turkish Council of Higher Education, namely, “Wyższa Szkoła Bankowa w Gdansk, Wyższa Szkoła Bankowa w Poznan, Wyższa Szkoła Bankowa w Torun, Wyższa Szkoła Bankowa w Wroclaw”, we are informed by the Turkish Council of Higher Education that the aforementioned schools are already included among those considered as recognizable.

The Turkish Council of Higher Education informs additionally that, according to the article 7/p of the Higher Education Law No. 2547, recognition procedures of the diplomas acquired through formal education and issued by the foreign higher education institutions (HEIs) are carried out in accordance with the provisions of the “Regulations on Recognition and Equivalence of Foreign Higher Education Diplomas” published in the Official Gazette dated 5 December 2017 and numbered 2880. Accordingly, the equivalence applications are evaluated and determined separately in each individual case by the Equivalence Commission and other relevant boards. Thus, it is indicated that, it is not possible to decide in advance whether the associate, undergraduate and master's degree diplomas received from recognized foreign HEIs in question are equivalent or not. Moreover, the Turkish Council of Higher Education reserves the right to make new decisions about the recognition of the foreign HEIs.
